

## **DO'S and DON'TS**

### **PLEASE:**

**Do** dress your child appropriate to the weather, because children will be going outside whenever possible.

**Do** notify the day care provider as soon as possible in case of your child's illness.

**Don't** bring your child to the day care center if the child is not feeling well and he/she requires the increased attention of an adult, i.e.,

Fever  
Diarrhea  
Vomiting  
Contagious Disease  
Severe cold

In consideration of the other children, please.

**Do** feed your child if he/she comes to the day care home later than 8:00 a.m.

**Do** label every item brought to the day care home.

**Don't** misunderstand! The purpose of the facility is a family day care. I am not a babysitter, but a child care provider.

**Don't** ask me to administer drugs.

Over the counter items will be used only if you have included them on the "NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION RECORD".

**DO** stay in the Pick up/Drop off area any time you are at the daycare. This applies at all times of the day. Children tend to behave out of character when their daily schedule is disrupted.
